NOT ALL DOGS LIKE DAYCARE

Daycare isn't for every dog: Some dogs stress being around so many other dogs. Some dogs simply cannot contain their excitement and become a danger to themselves and others. Some dogs would rather sleep at home. Some dogs are just not suited for daycare.

If you have been told your dog does not belong HERE, this does not mean; your dog is a bad dog. It does not mean your dog should not go to any daycare. It does not mean we hate your dog or its breed. It does not mean your dog is aggressive and unruly.

It simply means your dog is not enjoying being here, your dog would rather be anywhere else than here, your dog may end up causing a fight so we want to protect them and the other dogs, your dog would rather sleep, your dog isn't suited for OUR daycare.

You should certainly try another daycare, just because we think they aren't suited for here, does not mean they won't fit in beautifully somewhere else.

You should question us why we don't think they are suited. You should ask if there's anything you can do to help. You should consider that maybe your dog just wants to be at home.

Not all dogs are suited for daycare; just like not every human is suited to rave parties. Some dogs (and people) are better suited to hanging out at home and watching Netflix (that's more humans than dogs though).

This is NO reflection on YOU or your dog. It is what it is. We make the call based on what we see AT our daycare. We can't base it on what happens when your dog is at home, or at the park, or with another dog somewhere. All we know and see is what happens in front of us. If we feel your dog is a danger to others and themselves, we will ask that it doesn't come back. If we feel that your dog does not like daycare we will tell you and suggest that you don't bring them back. We will often try to give recommendations for what we may think could work for your dog. Chances are, we're in love with your dog almost as much as you, so we just want the best for them too.

Please feel welcome to ask or question the staff on the day about any behaviour issues or whether your dog is enjoying daycare or not. It is harder to answer questions after the day since it's not fresh in our minds and although you have ONE dog to focus on, we have many dogs to remember per day.

The main goal is to provide a safe environment for your dog and everyone else's dog. We would rather your dog was happy and safe than take your money and you and your dog not get any value from our service.
